Technical Topics for Workshops/ Training

Company Visit & Seminar Talk

Weekly company visits and seminar talks will be arranged with an aim to provide visiting students with knowledge in the obligations, roles and professional conduct of an engineer in a modern society. Eminent professionals are invited to deliver talks achieving the aims. Company visits to industry are organized for understanding the real-life environment about the management and organization, and trading practices of companies in the hosting countries/ areas.

Group Work/ Oral Presentation

Students will work in groups, each of which will be comprised of students from different universities, throughout the programme. Group Presentation is a requirement scheduled at the end of the summer camp for students to conclude and present what they have learned not only on technical skills and knowledge, but also on out-of-classroom aspects such as cultural difference, people they met, learning experience, etc.

Academic Talk

Academic Talk will be delivered in a relaxing atmosphere to give students a brief introduction of the latest research and technology development in the field.
